Annotated List of Subscribers

In the annotated list below the subscribers to the *Glossary* are grouped according to their background, showing which of them were members of the author's family, and beyond the family which of them had a clear connection with Pembrokeshire. Others came rather from Glamorganshire or Monmouthshire, from other parts of Wales, or from England. Within each regional group they have been divided into the following sets:-

Ordinary members of the public
Anglican and Nonconformist clergy
Antiquarians, Academics and Public Figures.

In some cases an individual could have been placed in more than one of the categories used here, and equally a different set of categories could have been used. Alternative approaches would inevitably yield a slightly different picture.

The entry for each person gives first his or her name and address in the form which is found in the list of subscribers in the *Glossary*. In addition a summary is given of what is known about this individual, including occupation, place of birth, the language(s) spoken, family relationship to William Meredith Morris himself or any other person appearing in the list, involvement in cultural activities, and published work on the Welsh language or its dialects.

This information is drawn from a variety of sources, including the *Census Returns*, *Crockford's Clerical Directory*, *Kelly's Trade Directory*, *The Dictionary of Welsh Bibliography*, *Who's Who*, *Who's Who in Wales*, and the annual reports of bodies such as the *University of Wales Guild of Graduates*, the *Historical Society of West Wales*, and the *Cambrian Archaeological Association*. The following abbreviations are used for convenience:-

- + Member of at least one historical society
- # Member of the University of Wales Guild of Graduates
- (D) Member of the Dialect Subsection of the Guild of Graduates

The 1891 and 1911 Census Returns for Wales reveal whether an individual spoke only Welsh, only English, or both languages, and the following abbreviations refer to this information. Where the person concerned was living in England, the Census Returns do not provide this information, and similarly, where he or she lived in Wales, but was absent from home at the time of the census, this information is not available. In some cases other sources allow this gap to be filled.
